Citilink and Ivy Tech Community College Northeast bring you an easy way to get around campus – **campusLink**. It's fast, free and easy. Save gas money. Park in one place and avoid busy parking lots later. Go green and preserve non-renewable fossil fuel, reduce pollution and shrink your carbon footprint by 209 pounds a day! This free shuttle service is for students, faculty, staff and even the general public to get around easily between Ivy Tech's Coliseum and North campuses.

Buses arrive every 20 minutes!

Get to class and avoid parking. Catch the **campusLink** shuttle and commute from one side of campus to the other in no time!

Service hours

campusLink operates during Ivy Tech's fall and spring semesters, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m.–6 p.m. There is no shuttle service on Saturdays, Sundays, Labor Day, Martin Luther King Day, Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break or Summer Break. Service is subject to shortened timeframes during finals week. Please check service hours during those weeks during the academic calendar. Citilink fixed route service does not operate on Sundays, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

How to ride and stay safe:

Go to a bus stop on the campusLink route.

Buses arrive every 20 minutes. See the route map and stop schedule for frequency at each location.

Wait for your bus. As buses approach, check the sign on the front of the bus for the name of the route. This will tell you where the bus is headed next based on the route schedule (Northbound v. Southbound).

Flag the bus at any safe intersection. Anywhere along the route above, you are able to step to the curb and hold your arm up high to let the driver know you need a ride.

Get on the bus. All buses are wheelchair accessible and are equipped with bicycle racks. Never cross in front of a bus.

Find a seat. If no seat is available, stand in the aisle and hold onto the rail when the bus is in motion. Always follow instructions from the driver.

Get off the bus. Let the driver know one block prior to your desired stop by pulling the yellow cord.

Get discount Citilink passes.

Purchase a discount standard 31-day bus pass and get anywhere in the city...for pennies!

These are available to Ivy Tech students, faculty, and staff and can be purchased at the Ivy Tech Bursar in the Express Enrollment Center at the Student Life Center on the North Campus. Discount Citilink bus passes are also available from other local universities with valid school ID.

PROHIBITED WHILE RIDING CAMPUSLINK: profanity or loud, abusive or disruptive behavior; consumption of alcoholic beverages; playing of any audio device without earphones; weapons of any kind or hazardous materials (gas cans, car batteries, etc.); standing in front of the yellow line; littering, destroying or vandalizing any property; and any other activity prohibited by law.
Failure to respect any of these restrictions may result in removal from the bus.
