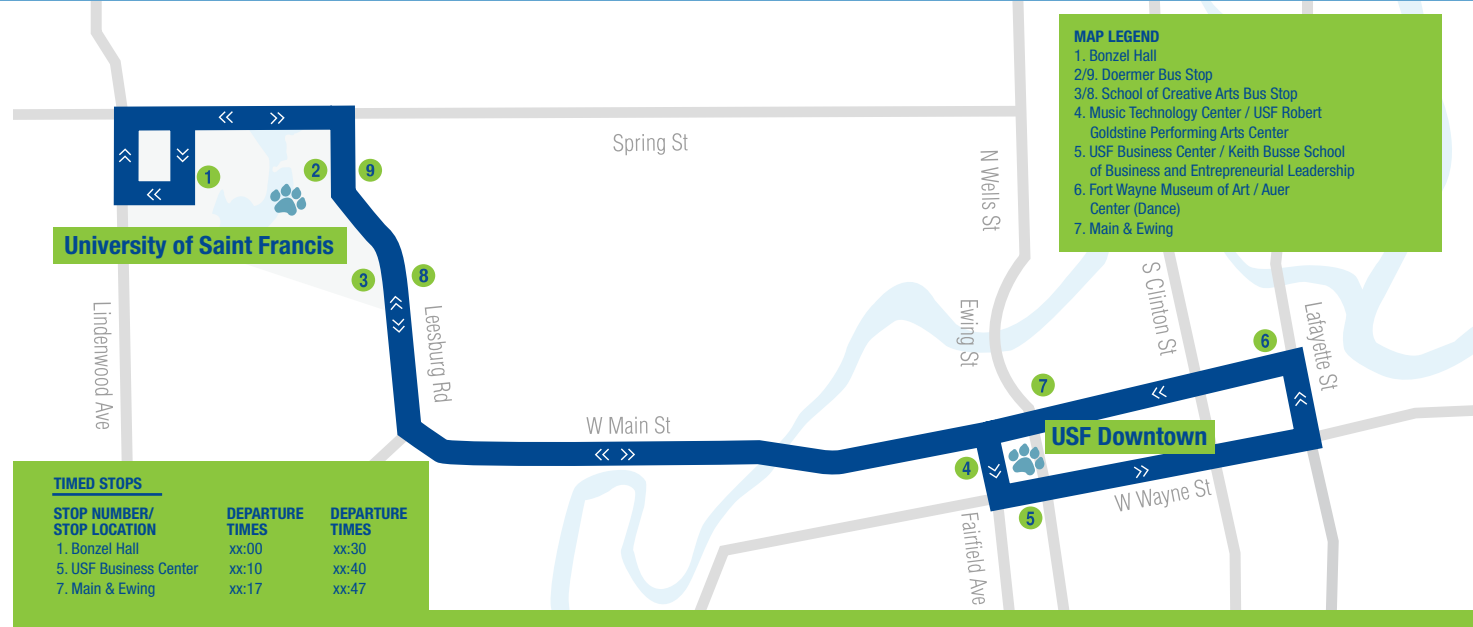

USF Cougar Express

- Cougar Express operates on school days during USF's fall and spring semesters. Monday through Friday, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.
- USF has alternate transportation options for 5 p.m.-9:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday. Visit sf.edu/about-usf/directions for more information.
- In addition to designated stops, the bus will stop at any safe intersection along the route.
- No Cougar Express bus service on Labor Day, fall recess, Thanksgiving break, winter break, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Easter break, last day of finals week, or summer break.
- Citilink Route 9 Saint Francis-Gateway provides hourly service from Spring Street to Downtown 5:30 a.m.-8:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

Discount Citilink bus passes are available!

Cougar Express is always free, but you can purchase a discount standard 31-day bus pass and get **anywhere in the city** for a lot less money! These are available to USF students, faculty and staff and can be purchased at the USF Business Office on the Spring Street campus.

How to ride and stay safe

Go to a bus stop on the Cougar Express route. Buses arrive every 30 minutes. See the route map and stop schedule for frequency at each location.

Flag the bus at any safe intersection. Anywhere along the route, you are able to step to the curb and hold your arm up high to let the driver know you need a ride.

Wait for your bus. As buses approach, check the sign on the front of the bus for the name of the route. This will tell you where the bus is headed next based on the route schedule.

Get on the bus. All buses are wheelchair accessible and are equipped with bicycle racks. Never cross in front of a bus.

Find a seat. If no seat is available, stand in the aisle and hold onto the rail when the bus is in motion. Always follow instructions from the driver.

Get off the bus. Let the driver know one block prior to your desired stop by pulling the yellow cord.
