



### **Executive Summary**



#### **Purpose**

ETC Institute administered a survey to Allen County residents for Citilink Fort Wayne. The purpose of the survey was to gather resident input and feedback on Citilink services. The information will be used to improve Citilink services and to help identify and address challenges facing the community and prioritize resources effectively. This is the first community survey ETC Institute has administered for Citilink.

#### Methodology

The five-page survey, cover letter and postage paid return envelope were mailed to a random sample of households in Allen County. The cover letter explained the purpose of the survey and encouraged residents to either return their survey by mail or complete the survey online. At the end of the online survey, residents were asked to enter their home address, this was done to ensure that only responses from residents who were part of the random sample were included in the final survey database. ETC Institute then matched the address provided by respondents who completed the survey with the addresses that were selected for the sample to ensure the participant is part of the sample. If a respondent did not provide an address or the address was not part of the sample, it was held separate from the database. ETC Institute followed-up with residents who received the mailed survey and promoted awareness of the survey using social media ads on Facebook and Instagram to encourage participation.

The goal was to obtain completed surveys from at least 400 residents. This goal was met, with a total of 418 residents completing the survey. Of the 418 completed surveys, 290 were from residents of the City of Fort Wayne and New Haven, and 128 were from residents of Allen County outside city limits. The overall results for the sample of 418 residents have a precision of at least  $\pm 4.79\%$  at the 95% level of confidence.

#### **Notes on Reporting:**

The combination of top two box responses such as "very satisfied" or "satisfied" has been used to represent results for the purpose of this executive summary and throughout this report.

The percentage of "don't know" responses has been excluded from many of the graphs shown in this report to facilitate valid comparisons. Since the number of "don't know" responses often reflect the utilization and awareness of services, the percentage of "don't know" responses have been provided in the tabular data section of this report.

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#### **Overview**

#### **Public Transportation Views**

Eighty-seven percent (87%) of Allen County residents indicated that public transportation is very important to the community. Only five percent (5%) of residents indicated that public transportation was not important to the community.

Seventy-nine percent (79%) of residents indicated that public transportation has a high impact on the local economy.

#### **Citilink Services**

Sixty percent (60%) of residents indicated based on their personal experience they believe Citilink is doing an "excellent" or "good" overall job in providing transit service.

When residents were asked to select the services that they think Citilink provides, the top 4 services selected were: 1.) Fixed route bus lines, 2.) Access (paratransit), 3.) Medicaid waiver-eligible transportation, and 4.) Shuttles.

Residents were surveyed on the importance of various public transportation functions provided by Citilink. The highest priorities identified included providing fast, frequent, reliable service on the City's main arterial streets, supporting economic development, access to jobs, and low-income housing developments, and making it easier to get to/from transit.

Residents identified the most important groups for Citilink to serve as: 1.) Low-income individuals, 2.) People with disabilities or elderly individuals, and 3.) Veterans.

#### Statements about Citilink

The highest levels of agreement with statements about Citilink were public transportation is important for a thriving community (93%), I feel Citilink vehicles are mechanically safe (83%), and the community's investment in transit provides value (81%). The lowest levels of agreement were Citilink manages its financial resources well (53%), Citilink's financial reporting is understandable and transparent (47%), and I feel safe while waiting at a Citilink bus stop (44%). The statements that residents indicated should receive the most emphasis over the next five years were: 1.) Citilink services are accessible to people with various disabilities, 2.) Public transportation is important for a thriving community and 3.) I feel safe while waiting at a Citilink bus stop.

The highest priorities for Citilink according to ETC's Importance-Satisfaction Analysis for these statements were 1.) I feel safe while waiting at a Citilink bus stop, and 2.) Citilink services are accessible to people with various disabilities. Improvements in these areas will maximize the overall satisfaction among residents of Allen County.

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#### **Citilink Usage**

Twenty-Nine percent (29%) of residents indicated they have used Citilink in the past 12 months.

- Of those that have used Citilink in the past 12 months, seventy-nine percent (79%) of residents rated the overall value that Citilink provides the community as "excellent" or "good."
- Sixty-five percent (65%) of the residents that have used Citilink in the past 12 months believe Citilink effectively serves the needs of the community
- The top reasons that residents have not used Citilink are 1.) Lack of need, 2.) Prefer personal vehicle, and 3.) Inconvenient routes or schedules.
- Residents were asked to select what would motivate them to use public transportation services in Allen County. The top three were: 1.) Transit services go where I need them to go (e.g., to work, medical appointments, education, visiting friends), 2.) Routes or stops near my home or work, and 3.) Hours of service (e.g., when the buses are running).
- Residents were asked to rate how likely they are to recommend using Citilink to friends or colleagues on a scale from 1-10. Based on their responses, ETC Institute categorized them using the Net Promoter Score (NPS) into three groups: Promoters, Passives, and Detractors. The breakdown for Allen County residents is as follows:

Promotors: 35%Passives: 22%Detractors: 43%

#### **Additional Funding**

Seventy-four percent (74%) of residents indicated they would be supportive of additional funding for public transportation to expand its services.

Residents were asked to rate how supportive they would be of potential funding sources. The sources that residents indicated they would support most were private contributions from foundations or businesses (82%), state funding: Increase to state contribution of the Public Mass Transit fund (PMTF) (79%), and direct contribution from the City of Fort Wayne (78%). The sources with the lowest level of support were Property Tax: Increase to property taxes ranging from \$4-\$15 annually (43%), and Payroll Tax: Increase to payroll taxes ranging from \$2-\$5 per paycheck (36%). The two sources that residents indicated they would be most supportive of were state funding and a direct contribution from the City of Fort Wayne.

The greatest concern among Allen County residents about increasing funding for public transportation is increased taxes. Increased service reliability, better communication about services, and demonstrated community benefits are the improvements that would encourage residents to support increase funding for Citilink.

When asked which areas should be prioritized for public transportation expansion, residents indicated the top three of new routes in underserved areas (69%), connecting service to the airport & nearby employers (55%), and expanded service hours (49%).

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#### **Additional Findings**

- 60% of residents get news and information about Citilink from local news sources.
  - Aligning communication sources with residents preferences can provide an opportunity for Citilink to increase awareness of services and community benefits.
- Residents were asked which types of transportation they would be most likely to use, the results were:
  - Commuter rail connecting larger cities (71%)
  - Curb to curb service for seniors or persons with disabilities (63%)
  - Bus service that operates on fixed routes in the area where you live (62%)
  - On-demand service that operates in a similar manner to Uber and Lyft (57%)
  - High-speed, rapid bus service that has priority at traffic lights and makes minimal stops (54%)
  - Vanpool service, which would involve having people who work at the same place and live near each other share a van (41%)
  - o Microtransit like scooters and e-bikes in urban areas like downtown (33%)


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

# Q1. How Important Do You Feel Public Transportation Is To The Community?



## Q2. How Much Impact Do You Think Public Transportation Has On The Local Economy?




# Q3. Rate The Level Of Importance For Each Of The Following Transportation Purposes...




# Q4. Which Of The Following Services Do You Think Citilink Provides?






## Q6. Please Rate How Important It Is For Citilink To Serve The Following Groups.






## Q7. Please Indicate Your Level Of Agreement With Each Statement In The List Below.


## Q8. Which THREE Of The Items In Question 7 Do You Think Should Receive The MOST EMPHASIS Over The Next Five Years?

by percentage of respondents who selected the item as one of their top three choices




### Q9. Have You Ridden Citilink In The Past 12 Months?




## Q9a. How Would You Rate The Overall Value That Citilink Brings To The Community?




# Q9b. Do You Believe Citilink Effectively Serves The Needs Of The Community?


## Q9c. If You Haven't Ridden Citilink In The Past 12 Months, What Are The Main Reasons You Have Not Used Citilink Services?


# Q10. What Would Motivate You To Use Public Transportation Services In Allen County?

by percentage of respondents (multiple selections could be made)





## Q12. How Supportive Would You Be For Additional Funding For Public Transportation To Expand Its Services?






## Q14. Which THREE Of The Options Listed In Question 13 Do You Feel The MOST SUPPORTIVE Of As Potential Funding Sources?




## Q15. Which Of The Following Is Your Greatest Concern About Increasing Funding For Public Transportation?




### Q16. Which THREE Of The Areas Do You Think Should Be Prioritized For Public **Transportation Expansion?**



### Q17. What Improvements Would Most Encourage You To Support Increased Funding For Citilink? by percentage of respondents (excluding not provided)




## Q18. Where Do You Currently Get News And Information About Citilink?




### Q19. What Other Transportation Options Do You Use?








## Q24. Are You Or Any Members Of Your Family Of Hispanic, Spanish, Or Latino/A/X Ancestry?


## Q25. Which Of The Following Best Describes Your Race/Ethnicity?

by percentage of respondents




## Q26. Would You Say Your Total Annual Household Income Is...


# Q27. What Is Your Employment Status?


# Q28. What Is Your Highest Level Of Education?

by percentage of respondents (excluding prefer not to say)




# Q29. Do You Have A Physical Disability That Causes You To Be Dependent On Others For Transportation?




## Q30. Do You Own Or Rent Your Current Residence?

# ETC's Importance-Satisfaction Analysis

## **Importance-Satisfaction Analysis**



## **Importance-Satisfaction Overview**

Today, officials have limited resources which need to be targeted to activities that are of the most benefit to their residents. Two of the most important criteria for decision making are (1) to target resources toward services of the highest importance to residents; and (2) to target resources toward those services where residents are the least satisfied.

The Importance-Satisfaction (IS) rating is a unique tool that allows public officials to better understand both of these highly important decision-making criteria for each of the services they are providing. The Importance-Satisfaction rating is based on the concept that public agencies will maximize overall customer satisfaction by emphasizing improvements in those areas where the level of satisfaction is relatively low, and the perceived importance of the service is relatively high.

## Methodology

The rating is calculated by summing the percentage of responses for items selected as the first, second, and third most important services for Citilink to provide. The sum is then multiplied by 1 minus the percentage of respondents who indicated they were positively satisfied with Citilink's performance in the related area (the sum of the ratings of 4 and 5 on a 5-point scale excluding "Don't Know" responses). "Don't Know" responses are excluded from the calculation to ensure the satisfaction ratings among service categories are comparable.

## [IS=Importance x (1-Satisfaction)]

Example of the Calculation: Respondents were asked to identify the services they think are most important for Citilink to emphasize. Thirty percent (30.2%) of respondents selected I feel safe while waiting at a Citilink bus stops as the most important service for Citilink to emphasize.

Regarding satisfaction\*, forty-four percent (43.6%) of respondents surveyed rated I feel safe while waiting at a Citilink bus stops as a "4" or "5" on a 5-point scale (where "5" means "strongly agree") excluding "Don't Know" responses. The I-S rating for I feel safe while waiting at Citilink bus stops was calculated by multiplying the sum of the most important percentages by 1 minus the sum of the satisfaction percentages. In this example 30.2% was multiplied by 76.8% (1-0.436). This calculation yielded an I-S rating of 0.1703 which ranked first out of twelve services.

## **Importance-Satisfaction Analysis**



The maximum rating is 1.00 and would be achieved when 100% of the respondents select an item as one of their top three choices to emphasize over the next two years and 0% indicate they are positively satisfied with the delivery of the service.

The lowest rating is 0.00 and could be achieved under either of the following two situations:

- If 100% of the respondents were positively satisfied with the delivery of the service
- If none (0%) of the respondents selected the service as one of the three most important areas for the City to emphasize over the next five years.

## **Interpreting the Ratings**

Ratings that are greater than or equal to 0.20 identify areas that should receive significantly more emphasis over the next two years. Ratings from 0.10 to 0.20 identify service areas that should receive increased emphasis. Ratings less than 0.10 should continue to receive the current level of emphasis.

- Very High Priority / Significantly Increase Emphasis (IS>=0.20)
- High Priority / Increase Emphasis (0.10<=IS<0.20)
- Medium Priority / Maintain Current Emphasis (IS<0.10)</li>

The "Most Important" percentage represents the sum of the first, second, and third most important responses for each item. Respondents were asked to identify the items they thought should be the City's top priorities.

The "Satisfaction" percentage represents the sum of the ratings "5" and "4" excluding don't knows.' Respondents ranked their level of satisfaction with each of the items on a scale of 1 to 5 with "5" being Very Satisfied and "1" being Very Dissatisfied.

- Longer service hours, and a seven day a week schedule.

- Adding a tram that goes around Fort Worth but connects to Citilink bus stops.
- All students should ride for free with a student ID.
- An inter-urban trolly system either for connecting Allen County cities or an expansion to connecting the region via and inter-urban trolly system.
- Better bus drivers A lot of the female drivers talk to much about passengers and harassment to passengers
- cheaper prices, more routes in neighborhoods, gas p powered buses no routes down town Fort Wayne, Go into housing additions and run on Sundays and all holidays and longer hours.
- Circular urban trolly type system during high volume periods for that area.
- Clean up transient people that leave main station nasty and dangerous for most riders
- Commuter rail to other cities! Bring back the Interurban!
- Currently the busses don't run late enough for me to use them to work past 7pm, if I do work late I have to find a ride. During bad weather it would be nice if the bus driver would communicate to the passengers that a one hour reset is happening and not leave us guessing I only had 15 minutes to make to the pharmacy for a prescription when I should have had well over an hour to make it safely. (January, 2025) Currently the bus system has a hub & spokes (routes) but no 'wheel'. Having buses going on fixed routes for areas around Fort Wayne with matching connections with the routes coming from downtown would make the most sense.
- Downtown is growing and provides activities. Citilink should provide transportation
- Effort to improve public opinion in positive ways. Testimonials, demonstration of positive ride experiences.
- Expand bus hours to at least midnight for those who work second shift.
- Expand routes longer operations going daily
- Expand routes, accessibility, more covered waiting areas
- Expand. Fort Wayne is growing. We need public transit to grow as well.
- Expanded commuter lines/times. Affordable.
- Expanding hours of operation. I work in social services and many of my clients rely on Citilink bus services to get around. However, many of them also work 3rd shift. Having the busses run later into the night would allow my clients more job opportunities because they would be able to get a ride home from work. Also expanded bus routes to the airport and Amazon facility.
- Expanding routes for those with disabilities to have better access to the services they need.
- Extend hours of bus service also offer service on Sunday and extend routes or get fixed routes for places like airport ND jobs out there where no bus goes
- Extended to airports and various outer communities, and longer service provision on Sundays and public holidays
- Find a better way to get funding for city link we have enough taxes taken out for a lot of other things in this city

- Highly used shelters need more benches and covers.
- Honestly I do not know enough about Citilink to answer.
- I cannot wait for the day Indiana takes public transportation seriously.
- I don't know. Maybe more service to get to downtown and other locations for festivals and
  community events. I don't go to festivals anymore because they closed the parking lot and put up
  that apartment building downtown beside Hall's gas house. I am a senior citizen, and it is just too
  much walking to get to Headwaters Park area. They should've built another parking garage
  instead of an apartment building
- I feel hours should be extended, it also should run on weekends also
- I worry about the bus riders that have to wait at stops that are not clearly marked. Every stop should have weather protection.
- I would say my previous comments are a good summary. I've ridden the bus for 40 years in Fort Wayne, actually longer than that my first bus rides I was 13 years old going from Waynedale to the downtown library. During that time period I have had many wonderful interactions with CityLink bus drivers but I have to say that during The last 5 years that has become something of the past. When you board a bus and you look the bus driver in the face smile and say good morning and they look at you and then stare straight ahead out the bus windshield without acknowledging even so much as your presence, that tells me that's not a people person and probably shouldn't be interacting with the public and probably should not be an employee of CityLink. However, I get it, sometimes people have a bad day. So you attempt to be friendly a second time to get the same response and then you know. I have never in 45 years of riding City Link buses encountered so many absolutely miserable, unhappy, not friendly, and sometimes even rude bus drivers. You can tell they don't like their job, they don't like you, maybe they don't even like themselves. The other thing I would say is don't talk about expanding services when you're in the middle of a s\*\*\* hole financially. There should be services on Sundays and the weekend service should be exactly the same times and routes as the weekday schedule. Most people that ride buses don't work at businesses that operate from 8:00 to 4:00 or 9:00 to 5:00 and only on Monday through Friday. CityLink needs to fix what broken within the service delivery goals that exist before ever even thinking about expanding in any way shape or form. When you can't afford to build a bus Hut, don't replace the route signs that were taken down how can you actually talk about having high speed bus services that don't stop for lights, give me a break. Somebody's having a fantasy I really need the reality check. I also didn't hear one thing about Federal funding. It's my understanding that most funding first City Link and other Urban transit systems comes from the federal government department of transportation. So why are we talking about raising property taxes are having a deduction taken out of a payroll check, and not even mentioning Federal funds. I think federal state and city should pay for CityLink. Do not raise my property taxes for bus service!
- I would suggest better training, some times they throw me from my seat when the bus comes to a stop. I think some do it on purpose.
- If you have to be at work at 4pm, you have to leave at 2:50. If you work until 11pm or later, there's no busses. Drivers have become very rude in the last few years. Busses run early, they run late, they leave you sitting downtown for an hour. They should run every 8 minutes 24/7, like everywhere else in the world.
- I'm not sure how you can improve the scheduling for access but IT REALLY needs to be addressed
- Increase service hours. Improve schedule reliability
- Increased service hours, including Sundays. Better service in southwest. Diversion buses are airless and terribly hot.
